A Celtic city heavily inspired by the Greeks and later Romans, the archaeological site of Glanum boasts the unique ancient remains of an entire town that had an undeniable influence between the 6th century BC and the 3rd century AD. This urban complex incorporating a number of civil and religious monuments is the only one of its kind in Provence.
